



The City of Fayette Will Use SeeClickFix to Improve Quality of Life, Encourage Greater Civic Participation

Fayette, Alabama - Today, the City of Fayette has partnered with SeeClickFix to announce a new platform (called “**Fayette 311**”) that will allow residents to report quality-of-life issues and request City of Fayette services.

With the free SeeClickFix mobile app, the City website, the Fayette Chamber website, Chamber Facebook page, or SeeClickFix website, Fayette citizens will now be able to provide City Staff with pictures, videos, specific descriptions, and more — valuable information needed to get the job done more efficiently. In addition, the SeeClickFix platform will provide City officials with a centralized issue management system to manage issues from creation to resolution — engaging Fayette citizens throughout the process.

This partnership not only allows Fayette citizens to report problems, but also to view, comment on, and vote to fix problems submitted by their neighbors. Citizens can even create their own “watch areas” to receive notifications about all the issues reported in their community, enabling them to follow the progress of all service requests — not just the ones they report.
