New City Hall Fayette, Alabama September 8, 2016

A special meeting of the City Council of the City of Fayette, Alabama, was held at 5:00 p.m. o'clock, p.m. on September 8, 2016 in the Council Chambers of City Hall.

Upon roll call the following were found to be present: Mayor Ray Nelson, Council members Linda McCraw, Mike Hardin, Jason Cowart, Cedric Wilson and David Brand. Also present were City Engineer Dewayne Roby, Assistant Street Department Superintendent Marty Weeks and City Attorney Dale Lawrence.

Mayor Nelson announced that a quorum was present and that the meeting was open for the transaction of business.

INTERVIEW OF CITY MECHANIC/SHOP SUPERINTENDENT APPLICANTS

Mayor Nelson announced that this was the day and time for the interviews of the top five applicants for the position of City Mechanic/City Shop Superintendent. The applicants were interviewed in the following order:

- 1. Curtis R. Moore
- 2. Charles R. Campbell
- 3. Austin Brasher
- 4. Jason Selman
- 5. Tyler Wheat

Each applicant was asked about their experience as a mechanic and welder and also, their experience in supervising others and preparing and maintaining proper paperwork and records.

At the conclusion of the interviews, the Mayor and Council each wrote down their top three candidates. If a candidate was the first choice – he received 3 points, if second choice – 2 points and if third choice – 1 point. The submissions of the Mayor and Council were then tabulated. The most any candidate had the possibility of receiving was 18 points (six 1st choice votes x 3 points = 18). All of the candidates received points. Mr. Curtis Moore received 16 points. The next highest candidate received 8 points.

Councilmember Cowart moved that the Council consent to the Mayor hiring Mr. Curtis Moore as City Mechanic/City Shop Superintendent at a salary of \$40,000.00 per year. Upon the motion being seconded by Councilmember Hardin, the same was unanimously adopted.

ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business to come before the Council, upon the motion to adjourn being made by Councilmember Wilson and seconded by Councilmember Cowart, the same was unanimously adopted.
