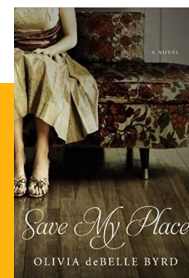
June 18 | Didgeridoo Down Under | 2:00-3:00 PM

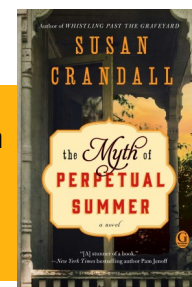
June 25 | Light Saber Sensory Bottles | 2:00-3:00 PM
