TELEPHONE CONFERENCE WITH OPIOD COUNSEL

Mr. Keith Jackson of Jackson Riley reported to the Council on the ongoing opioid litigation and the Endo Settlement. He stated they have been negotiating with the opioid companies and also with the State of Alabama on how any monies would be divided between the state and the local governments. He explained how monies would be allocated between the political subdivisions.

Mr. Jackson reported the case with Endo had been settled. He said they had not expected to receive any money from Endo because they expected them to go into bankruptcy. He stated from the settlement the City would be allocated a gross payment of \$10,455.00.
