The City Council of the City of Fayette held a special meeting at 4:00 o'clock, p.m. on March 28, 2022, in the Council Chambers of the City Hall.

Upon roll call the following were found to be present: Mayor Rod Northam, Councilmembers Virettia L. Whiteside, Eddy Campbell, Tommy Williams and Jerry Nichols. Also present were City Clerk Dawn Clapp and City Attorney Dale Lawrence. Councilmember Hughes-Monroe was absent.

BID ON CIVIC CENTER CARPET REPLACEMENT

Mayor Northam stated the City had received one bid for the replacement of the carpet at the Fayette Civic Center. The bid was from Rebasco Decorators in the amount of \$57,525.00. He recommended the Council accept the lowest bid. Councilmember Whiteside moved the Council adopt the following resolution:

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Fayette that it hereby awards the bid for the replacement of the carpet at the Fayette Civic Center to the lowest responsible bidder, Rebasco Decorators, in the amount of \$57,525.00.

BID ON STREET AND SANITATION DEPARTMENT BUILDING

Mayor Northam stated the City had received one bid for the Street & Sanitation Department building. The bid was from Construction Specialty Associates, Inc. in the amount of \$129,500.00.

Councilmember Williams moved the Council reject all bids. Upon the motion being seconded by Councilmember Nichols, the same was unanimously approved.
