

Work Session

The City Council of the City of Fayette held a work session at 7:00 o'clock, p.m. on September 15, 2025, in the Council Chambers of the City Hall.

Upon roll call the following were found to be present: Mayor Rod Northam, Councilmembers Steve Herring, Eddy Campbell, Tommy Williams and Aliska Hughes-Monroe. Also present was City Attorney Dale Lawrence. Councilmember Jerry Nichols was absent.

The opening prayer was given by Ward 5 Councilmember-elect Floyd Rodgers, Jr.

Mayor Northam announced a quorum was present and the meeting was open for the transaction of business.

#### PROPOSED BUDGET

Mayor Northam presented the proposed budget for the upcoming fiscal year to the Council for their consideration. He said in the proposed budget the Sewer Department would be shifted from the Street Department to the Waste Water Department and that two new employees would be hired for the Sewer Department. He said the proposed budget also contains funding for the hiring of three additional firefighters who would be EMS certified and two additional police officers. The budget also includes the increases in medical insurance of 13.88% and dental insurance of 3.35%. There was no increase in the vision insurance.

Mr. Rick McCabe reviewed the proposed budget with the Council. He reviewed the anticipated revenues and expenses of the City with the Council. He said in the budget he projected the City's monthly sales tax revenue to be \$295,000.00.

#### ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business to come before the Council, upon the motion to adjourn being made by Councilmember Campbell and seconded by Councilmember Herring, it was unanimously approved.
