Auburn, Extension Weed Scientists Detail the New Dicamba Requirements

In 2025, row crop producers faced regulatory changes regarding the widely used herbicide, dicamba. This product was effectively removed from legal use for over-the-top applications that season. However, in February 2026, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency allowed the registration of three new dicamba-based products but with new stipulations. Auburn University researchers and Alabama Extension specialists continue to guide growers through these new labels and requirements. [Read More](#)
